The Bayshore Discovery Project's mission is to motivate people to take care of the history, the culture and the environment of New Jersey's Bayshore region through education, preservation and example. Originally established in 1988, the



organization spent eight years painstakingly restoring the 1928 Delaware Bay Oyster Schooner A.J. MEERWALD, which is on the National Register of Historic Places.

The award winning schooner now serves as a living classroom on the Bay as well as New Jersey's Official Tall Ship. Thousands of school children each year come aboard and experience a multidisciplinary sail, learning ecology, history and culture while taking in the sights, sounds and activity of the glorious Delaware Bay.



The A.J. MEERWALD is certified by the US Coast Guard, fully insured, and staffed by professional crew members and educators.

Bayshore Discovery Project recently completed restoration is the 1904 Oyster Shipping Sheds and Wharves, which served as the centerpiece of the oyster industry back when Port Norris was known as the Oyster Capital of the World. The sheds serve as homeport to the MEERWALD and house the Delaware Bay Museum & Folklife Center, a gallery and gift shop, & the Oyster Cracker Café. BDP hosts events & educational programs throughout the year, including the monthly



"Second Fridays by the Bay", and Delaware Bay Day, a free seafood and folklife festival held annually on the first Saturday in June.

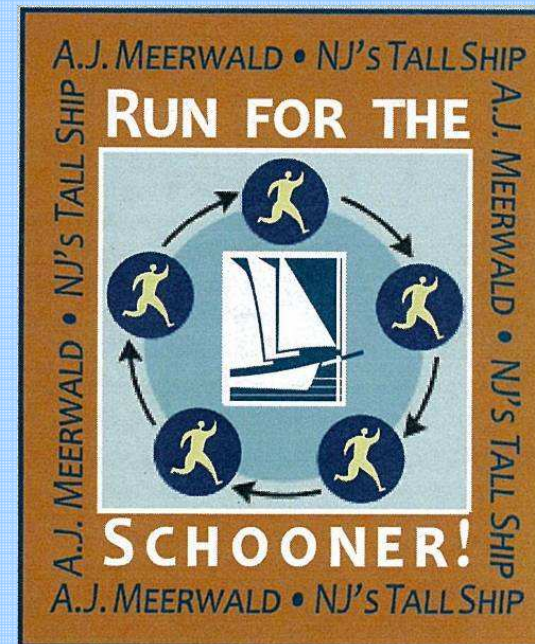
