5K RUN/1 MILE WALK

The Quarterback Scramble will kick-off with a kids TD run at 8:00 am. The 5K will begin at 8:15 am, followed by the 1 mile walk. This is a USATF certified course; the start/finish line is on 1st Avenue at 82nd Street Park.

The 5K will be a loop course through the tranquil town of Stone Harbor. There will be water stations on the course, as well as at the goal line (finish line). Digital clocks will be at the 1 and 2 mile markers.
