Where the Money Will Go

The 5K in May Run/Walk for Marianne will help combat pancreatic cancer on two fronts: Half the proceeds will go to the pancreatic cancer research division at Fox Chase Cancer Center and half will go to the AtlantiCare Cancer Care Institute.

Fox Chase Cancer Center was founded in 1904 in Philadelphia as the nation's first cancer hospital. In 1974, it became one of the first institutions designated as a National Cancer Institute Comprehensive Cancer Center. In addition to prevention, detection and treatment programs, Fox Chase has researchers devoted to improving outcomes for patients with pancreatic cancer and other forms of cancer. Researchers are also studying pancreatic cysts in hopes of developing diagnostic tests that would help doctors assess the cancerous potential of a patient's cyst.

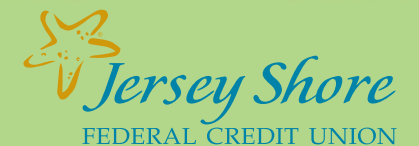

Pancreatic Cancer: A Silent Killer

Pancreatic cancer is sometimes called a "silent killer" because there are seldom any symptoms in its early stages. It often goes undetected until it's reached an advanced stage.

Since the disease is often advanced at the time of diagnosis, the prognosis is generally poor. Pancreatic cancer has one of the highest fatality rates of all cancers. About 38,000 Americans a year develop it and about 34,000 of them die from it, making it the fourth leading cause of cancer death for both men and women in the United States.

Complete remission is rare but may become more common if researchers succeed in their search for better treatments and for ways to detect the disease's presence earlier.

Who Was Marianne DiNofrio?



Marianne DiNofrio was born in Lorraine, OH and moved to Linwood in 1966. In 1973 she began working at Seaview Elementary School and continued working there for 35 years, even during chemotherapy. Children of Linwood knew and loved Marianne and remembered her for years after they left Seaview. She and her husband John created the Linwood Community Federal Credit Union in 1979, which grew to eventually become Jersey Shore Federal Credit Union.

Marianne was always the life of the party, an energetic dancer with her husband, and one who listened more than she spoke. She was the favorite “play date” to her five grandchildren and had the stamina to keep up with them. Her children John and Lori considered her their best friend, biggest fan and trusted confidante. She loved taking her family on vacations and even in her 70’s hiked and skied and rode roller coasters with them.

Marianne succumbed to pancreatic cancer on July 21, 2009.
